What can you find in the information room?

Archaeology

In the information room you find the register of ancient remains and you have access to archaeological reports.

Archives

Documents dealing mainly with people, enterprise, societies and houses are kept in the archive.

Buildings

Inventories of buildings, drawings and written communication dealing with various buildings are kept here.

Boatsmen from Blekinge

The register of Blekinge's boatswains is available on the computer in the information room.

Documentation

Documentation dealing with coastal culture, folk music, handicraft and industry can be studied here.

Ethnological records

The records contain stories of everyday life and various traditions.

Photographs

Most of the photos are sorted according to place, but you can also find portraits.

Objects

The objects of the museum are kept in the storehouse of Kungshall. In the information room you can use the database to find various objects.

Maps

Maps and drawings can be found in the archives of the museum.

Lilja's Blekinge collection

A large collection of excerpts containing data on events and people of Blekinge. You can find a register of about 46 000 people connected with the area.

Literature

The museum owns a large collection of literature on Blekinge. Other literature can also be found in the library.

The Swahn archives of building sites

By using these registers you can find information about owners of real estate in Karlskrona up till the beginning of the 20th century.

Newspaper clippings

From the beginning of the 20th century the museum has collected clippings on events and individuals.

Useful to know

How to order certain copies from the archives

Maps, drawings, documentation and certain copies have to be ordered and cannot always be delivered on the same day. Therefore, please let us know beforehand what you are looking for.

Loans and copying

No documents may be borrowed from the information room. Photocopies from certain books and documents can be made.

Bying pictures

Photos can be ordered at a minimum cost of 25 SEK. Special rules apply to pictures to be used for other purposes than private ones.
